George M. and Hilda G. Shrake Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended for an incoming freshman from a Wayne County high school with demonstrated financial need who is interested in pursuing a degree in engineering or computer science. Only students who have applied and been admitted to Michigan State University by March 31 of their senior year of high school will receive consideration.

Applicants are required to complete this form and attach a one-page essay describing their academic and extracurricular experiences, along with personal characteristics which have influenced their proposed course of study and career plans. The applicant's name should appear on both documents, and proofreading is highly recommended prior to submission.

The George M. and Hilda G. Shrake Endowed Scholarship has a minimum value of \$2000 for the freshman year. The scholarship will be renewed for recipients who maintain a cumulative 3.00 GPA at MSU, continue to actively pursue a degree in engineering or computer science, and provide an updated application by March 31 each year. Recipients who wish to renew this award should attach a one-page essay in which they comment on their experiences at MSU, their academic focus for the coming year, and their career plans beyond graduation. Recipients are expected to provide the donors with a letter of acknowledgement each year.
