> INTRODUCTION

Congratulations on your selection to compete in the 2022 Michigan State University Alumni Distinguished Scholarship (ADS) Competition. In-person testing is limited for the 2022 competition so the ADS examination will also be conducted in an online format via MSU's learning management system D2L and Respondus Monitor proctoring system. The cost of the examination is included in your ADS registration fee. Finally, the importance of this examination in the ADS Competition cannot be understated. It is imperative you complete the registration actions listed below to ensure your successful examination completion on test day.

> REGISTRATION

- 1) ADS candidates **must create** an MSU Guest Account to access the ADS Competition 2022 Examination Community in D2L at https://tech.msu.edu/msu-guest-account/.
